

Rob K. Fukuzaki Heads Up Youth Foundation Communications Scholarship University of La Verne

The \$2,500 Rob K. Fukuzaki Heads Up Youth Foundation Communications Scholarship has been established to assist worthy students in the Communications Department of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of La Verne.

Criteria

The scholarship will be awarded to a student of good character and work habits majoring in Journalism, Broadcast or Communications, and who has completed at least one semester in the Communications Department in the College of Arts and Sciences. The student must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 and be entering their junior or senior year. The student must also have a demonstrated financial need as defined by the Office of Financial Aid.

Application Process

Students must submit the following items in their completed application packet:

- Attached application form
- Personal statement (see details at the bottom of the next page)
- Two references on their behalf regarding their character and their work in the field of communications, either in the form of a letter or by filling out the attached form. These references must be from people outside the full-time faculty and staff of the University of La Verne Communications Department. For confidentiality, the references should be submitted in sealed envelopes with a signature across the seal.

Application information will be shared with the Rob K. Fukuzaki Heads Up Youth Foundation as part of the selection process. The recipient will be chosen by a committee consisting of University of La Verne Communications Department faculty members.

The application packet must be submitted to Malissa Hernandez or Eric Borer in ACB 107, no later than 5 p.m., May 2, 2018.
