

ULV Chamber Singers Auditions Fall 2020:

In an effort to continue singing during the pandemic, admission to our ensemble will be online. There are two parts to the online choral auditions. Please read the instructions carefully.

1a. Submit a short video of yourself singing in the style that features you best. (30 seconds- 1min). A cappella singing is fine. I highly recommend a song that demonstrates range.

1b. Record yourself singing the provided warm ups and submit audio files (only for warm ups #1, #2). This will allow the listener a better understanding of your range and quality of your voice.

Be sure to warm up prior to recording. Strive for warm resonant sound in your vocal tone. The first few warm ups will focus on your upper register.

- Warm Up #1: on the vowel “ NEE”- five note descending pattern.
- Warm Up #2: on the vowel “NAH”- three note ascending, hold on top, and same notes on the descent.
- Warm Up #3: on the vowel “NAH”- five note descending pattern focusing on the lower register
- Warm Up #5: on the vowel “ NEE- EH- AH” (Notes 1-2 sing Nee, notes 3-4 sing EH, notes 5 and down- the vowel AH)

Should the candidate pass the first part of the audition, singers will be invited to interview and sight read for Dr. Messoloras.
