The University of La Verne will offer two \$25,000 scholarships with fourth year full tuition in each of the six featured performance areas for the 2021-2022 academic year. These competitive Performance Scholarships are renewable annually for up to four years of undergraduate study based on the student's academic progress (must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA), as well major or minor in the performance area (see Area-Specific Requirements for details). **Scholarships are for incoming freshmen, international and transfer students.**

To be considered for fall 2021, applicants must submit a completed application for admission to the University of La Verne, as well as the Performance Scholarship application, recommendation form, and Area-Specific Requirements electronically by January 10, 2021. Applicants are strongly encouraged to apply for state and federal student aid.

Scholarship applicants must be admitted to the University of La Verne prior to Performance Scholarship Day, which will be held on Friday, Feb. 26, 2021. **Attendance at Performance Scholarship Day is required, and is by invitation only.***
