Join the University of La Verne's vibrant community of creative artists and performers!

The University of La Verne will offer \$30,000 scholarships to 12 students in eight featured performance categories for the 2024-2025 academic year.

These competitive Performance Scholarships are renewable annually for up to four years of undergraduate study as long as the student maintains academic standards (a 3.0 cumulative GPA) and continues to meet area-specific requirements.

To be considered for Fall 2024, applicants must apply to the University of La Verne and complete a Performance Scholarship application. The Performance Scholarship application, recommendation form, and area-specific requirements must be submitted by midnight **February 2, 2024**. Application documents and additional information is available at univ.lv/performance.

Applicants may not be enrolled in any University of La Verne course prior to the Fall 2024 semester. Scholarship applicants must be admitted to the University of La Verne prior to Performance Scholarship Day on February 23, 2024. On Performance Scholarship Day, applicants will present their portfolios or perform an audition and/or interview with faculty and staff in their performance area. Attendance at Performance Scholarship Day is required and is by invitation only.*

**Auditions and/or interviews for out-of-area and international applicants who cannot attend Performance Scholarship Day will be conducted remotely.*
