Liberal Arts majors are encouraged to take LA 200: Foundations of Interdisciplinary Studies in their first year in place of a traditional WRT 111 class.

CORE: Liberal Arts Majors must take 22 semester hours of upper division classes with at least one course in Humanities (LA HU), Fine Arts (LA FA), Natural Science (LA NS), and Social Science (LA SS) but not more than two courses in any of those areas. Students may complete the 22 semester hours with 5 four-unit classes and one two-unit class.

CONCENTRATION: Liberal Arts majors must develop an interdisciplinary concentration (LA CO) consisting of three different disciplines and at least 12 hours of upper-division work.

Students in the Liberal Arts complete the major with LA 390 and LA 499/Senior Thesis as directed studies in the Senior year.

*The Liberal Arts major would require 49 units if none of the courses in the curriculum are also General Education courses. Foreign Language proficiency at the second-semester level may be certified through a placement exam or through a General Education Humanities class in the foreign language.

Liberal Arts majors will have at least 24 units of elective course work and may complete a minor in a chosen field.
