Core Requirements (take all 16 units):

- (4) PSY 390 Research Methods (pre-requisite is PSY 305)
- (4) PSY 400 History of Psychology (pre-requisite is PSY 101)
- (4) PSY 497 Internship (Junior or Senior standing only)
- (4) PSY 404: Experimental Psychology(pre-requisite is PSY 390) or PSY 499: Senior Thesis (pre-requisite is PSY 390)

Areas of Emphasis (take all 16 units):
